**LINA21, Linguistics: Level 2, 30 credits**  
*Lingvistik: Fortsättningskurs, 30 högskolepoäng*  
First Cycle / Grundnivå

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### Details of approval

The syllabus was approved by the programmes director by delegation from the pro-dean for first- and second-cycle studies on 2007-03-30 to be valid from 2007-03-30, autumn semester 2007.

### General Information

The course is offered as a single course. It can normally be included as part of a general degree at the undergraduate or graduate levels.

### Learning outcomes

On completion of the course the student shall

#### Knowledge and understanding

- be able to describe the various levels of language structure: phonetics, grammar, semantics and pragmatics
- be able to give an account of the nature of the linguistic connection between sound and meaning
- be able to explain in detail how phonemes sounds are produced and perceived, and be able to give an account of the acoustic correlates of sounds

### Competence and skills

- be able to give an account of and apply current tools of analysis for prosody, grammar, semantics, pragmatics, and phonetics
- be able to make valid generalisations on language type based on isolated examples of language
- be able to analyse sounds using a spectrogram
- be able to conduct relevant information searches, evaluate information and have a good command of reference systems within the discipline of linguistics

### Judgement and approach

- be able to relate, among other things, prosodic parameter to gender.

### Course content

The course provides in-depth studies of various central areas of linguistics, in order to enable the student to develop an independent position in relation to theories of linguistics and to be able to follow and assess various theories on an empirical basis. Focus is on the essential elements of phonetics (how speech is produced and understood, different sounds, intonation, stress, etc) and general linguistics (the link between meaning and form via pragmatics, semantics and grammar in a selection of languages from around the world).

The course consists of the following sub-courses:

1. Grammar, 7.5 credits,
2. Semantics and Pragmatics, 7.5 credits,
3. Voice and Speech, 7.5 credits,
4. Prosody, 7.5 credits.

### Course design

Teaching consists of lectures, group work, and individual work.

### Assessment

Examinations can take the following forms: invigilated examinations, group work and home assignments.

### Grades

Marking scale: Fail, Pass, Pass with distinction.

To be awarded a Pass on the whole course the student shall have passed all sub-courses. To be awarded a grade of Distinction on the whole course the student shall have a grade of Distinction on at least 15 of the course's credits, and a grade of Pass on the remaining credits.

## Entry requirements

To be eligible for the course requires the successful completion of LINA11 Linguistics Level 1, or the equivalent.
