General Information

Subject: Comparative Literature

The course is offered as a single course. It can normally be included as part of a general degree at the undergraduate or graduate levels. With the approval of the relevant authenticating body, it can also be included in certain professional degrees.

Learning outcomes

On completion of the course the student shall

Knowledge and understanding

- demonstrate basic knowledge and understanding of Swedish poetry, with an emphasis on 20th century lyric poetry
- demonstrate a sound understanding of poetic forms of expression

Competence and skills

- be able to analyse and interpret poetry
- be able to give an account of the relationship between poetry and society

- demonstrate a basic scholarly approach to information sources and literature, for example be able to examine texts critically after receiving instruction
- be able to write various types of text, such as a short analysis

Judgement and approach

• be able to give perspective on the role of poetry in contemporary times.

Course content

In the course a selection of Swedish poetry is studied, the majority of which is taken from the 20th century. A brief historical overview and tutoring in the analysis of lyrics aids the reading of poetry.

Course design

The course is a distance education course which utilises interactive information technology. It presupposes that the student has access to a computer with internet connection. The department can provide the student with details concerning technical demands. The course is offered as a part-time course.

Assessment

The following examination forms may occur: written tests at the end of the course, continuous assessment in the form of home assignments and through active participation in on-line discussion groups.
