Details of approval

The syllabus was approved by The Board of the Department of Business Administration on 2026-02-03. The syllabus comes into effect 2026-02-04 and is valid from the autumn semester 2026.

General information

MGTO53 is a course in Business Administration at the advanced level. This course is the first of two courses given in combination. The second course is MGTO52.

Learning outcomes

A passing grade on the course will be awarded to students who show:

Knowledge and understanding

- Demonstrate capacity to integrate and process theoretical and conceptual learning from the program through reflection in interactive sessions and writing.

Competence and skills

- Demonstrate capacity to reflect on one's own practice in the form of roles and participation in the program, in interactive sessions as well as in writing.

Judgement and approach

- Demonstrate insight into and take responsibility for the need for ongoing reflection on one's role and professional development.

Course content

Learning, development and change are key aspects of leadership. The course stresses the ability to reflect on their own learning, as well as tools for continued personal learning and development as leaders.

Course design

The course involves keeping a learning journal on an ongoing basis and participating in a number of tutorials. The course runs alongside other courses in the programme. MGTO53 is followed by MGTO52 in the spring term.

Assessment

Assessment and grading are based on:

- A continuous, individual written learning journal where students document, analyze and reflect on their individual learning and development in the program.
- Participation in tutorial sessions focusing on students' learning and development in the program.

A student who does not pass the individual written learning journal will be given an extra assignment. A student who does not pass the tutorials will be given an extra assignment.

The examiner, in consultation with Disability Support Services, may deviate from the regular form of examination in order to provide a permanently disabled student with a form of examination equivalent to that of a student without a disability.

Grades

Grading scale includes the grades: Fail, Pass

Entry requirements

Students admitted to the programme Master of Science in Management, where this course is a compulsory part, are qualified for the course.

An undergraduate degree (BA/BSc) equivalent to 180 credits. English 6/English course B.

Further information

The course MGTO53 cannot be combined with MGTO51 or MGTN51 in a degree.

In case of closure of the course: Within three semesters after the course closure there will be offered three additional occasions for examination of respective examination part of the course, for students with no successful result. Note that after this you can get a certificate only regarding completed examination parts.
