Details of approval

The syllabus was approved by Education Committee of the Performane and Church Music Department on 2023-04-26 (STYR2023/1002). The syllabus comes into effect 2023-07-01 and is valid from the autumn semester 2023.

General information

Freestanding course.

Learning outcomes

On completion of the course, the students shall be able to

- make connections between situations/events and a reflecting perspective.
- connect reflecting perspective with their own music-making.
- explain how principles of reflecting perspective function.

Course content

The course contains lectures, group work as well as dialogue in the group. With different issues and methods, what reflecting perspective is explored can make for the individual participant.

Course design

The course is carried out through workshops, seminar, group work, literature studies and reflection.

Assessment

In the examinations, the students' learning process through written presentation (own log book) is summarised and presented as well as orally in the group.

In the log book, the student should follow a timetable and every week write down reflections about their own training and connect it to the course content.

Intended course learning outcomes two be presented also in the form of a physical performance for the group.

The examiner, in consultation with Disability Support Services, may deviate from the regular form of examination in order to provide a permanently disabled student with a form of examination equivalent to that of a student without a disability.

Grades

Grading scale includes the grades: Fail, Pass

Entry requirements

Basic as well as specific entry requirements; studied or had studied at programme education at music university college (music performance and/or music teacher programme) or an equivalent discipline at least 7.5 credits.
