Details of approval

The syllabus was approved by Quality Board for First and Second-Cycle Education on 2024-11-20. The syllabus comes into effect 2024-12-15 and is valid from the spring semester 2025.

General information

Independent summer course held in collaboration with Blekinge International Brass Academy.

The course is aimed at brass musicians who are studying or have studied at a music academy or equivalent, as well as professionals wishing to specialise in playing brass solos and chamber music.

entry requirements

Learning outcomes

On completion of the course, the students shall be able to:

Knowledge and understanding

- have rehearsed different types of solo pieces for the instrument
- be familiar with different musical styles with relevant performance practice for brass repertoire.

Competence and skills

- express artistic thoughts and ideas at concert performances in front of an audience
- perform musical interplay in brass ensembles of varying size and with different musical styles
- have developed a practice method for rehearsing solo repertoire.

Judgement and approach

• independently distinguish and solve problems that arise during rehearsals and concerts.

Course content

The course contains interpretation studies of relevant works for the instrument, playing orchestral excerpts, participation in seminars, masterclasses and concerts.

Course design

Teaching is in the form of individual and group tuition, seminars, masterclasses and the organisation of concerts.

Assessment

Examination is through continuous assessment and at a concert.

The examiner, in consultation with Disability Support Services, may deviate from the regular form of examination in order to provide a permanently disabled student with a form of examination equivalent to that of a student without a disability.

Grades

Grading scale includes the grades: Fail, Pass

Entry requirements

General and specific entry requirements: studying or has studied at an educational programme at a music academy or equivalent, at least 7.5 credits instrumental studies for brass instruments.

Selection: artistic academic qualifications in music.

Selection takes place in selection groups to achieve a brass chamber music ensemble: horns, trumpet, trombone and tuba.
