Learning outcomes

The course turns above all to active musicians that want to specialise in chamber music from the baroque.

Knowledge and understanding

In addition to the general aims for first-cycle programmes that is formulated in the Higher Education Act (chapter 1, section 8) the student should

- acquired good proficiencies in basso continuo
- developed a good ability to improvise a style correctly and reasonable
- acquired good knowledge in behaviour practice in vocal/instrumental musicmaking

Course content

The course contains

- historical overview of ways of basso continuo and ways of playing
- studies of vowel and instrumental music with thorough bass (basso continuo).
- accompaniment on organ and harpsichord

Course design

The teaching is given as joint group lessons and individual work (exercise, preparations).

Assessment

Examination takes place through continuous assessment.
