General Information

Compulsory course in Bachelor's Programme in Music: Folk and World Music, first cycle 180 credits.

Main field of studies

Music

Learning outcomes

The aim of the course is to enable students to acquire the following knowledge and skills on completion of the course.

Knowledge and understanding

The student shall on completion of the course

- have basic skills on a chord instrument or second instrument and also
- have basic practical and theoretical knowledge of accompaniment and musical interplay.

Competence and skills

The student shall on completion of the course

- have basic skills in the implementing of practical and theoretical knowledge of accompaniment and musical interplay into artistic ideas.

Course content

The course can contain components regarding accompaniment and musical interplay in practical and theoretical playing. The emphasis is placed on playing from chord symbols but notated material can also occur. The course assumes approved result of earlier course MUUF50.

Course design

The course is carried out in the form of individual lessons or group lessons.

Assessment

Examination of the course is arranged through continuous assessment and tests. Examination rules, such as examination requirements and mark limits, shall be communicated to the student at the beginning of the course.

Re-examination of the course shall be offered in close connection to the regular examination.

The examiner, in consultation with Disability Support Services, may deviate from the regular form of examination in order to provide a permanently disabled student with a form of examination equivalent to that of a student without a disability.
