Learning outcomes

The aim of the course is to enable students to acquire the following knowledge and skills on completion of the course.

Knowledge and understanding

The student shall on completion of the course

- show well developed technical craftsmanship on the instrument and
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- when playing, show a well developed understanding of the style and expression of the current repertoire,
- have experience of methods and processes as well as in-depth studies within the

Competence and skills

The student shall on completion of the course

- show the ability to describe, analyse and interpret form, technique and content,
- show the ability to critically reflect on the personal artistic approach within a wider artistic context,
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- show the ability to create, realize and express personal ideas within the main field of study,
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- be able to identify, formulate and solve artistic problems and problems regarding interpretation and also
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- be able to carry out artistic assignments within given time frames.

Judgement and approach

The student shall on completion of the course

• show good ability to co-operate with other artists.

Course content

The content of the course is based on the individual student's needs. Together with the faculty management the student makes an individual study plan in which is placed strong emphasis on the student's needs and vision for musical development and direction. The course assumes approved result of earlier course MUUF84.

Course design

The course consists of individual lessons and individual work (practicing, preparations, projects) as well as group studies.

Assessment

Examination of the course is arranged through continuous assessment and tests/exams. Examination rules, such as examination requirements and mark limits, shall be communicated to the student at the beginning of the course.
