General Information

Compulsory course in Bachelor's Programme in Music: Individual Programme, first cycle 180 credits.

Main field of studies

Music

Learning outcomes

The aim of the course is to enable students to acquire the following knowledge and skills on completion of the course.

Knowledge and understanding

The student shall on completion of the course

- show good direction towards basic knowledge of the chosen specialisation.

Competence and skills

The student shall on completion of the course

- show good direction towards the ability to reflect on the personal artistic approach.

Judgement and approach

The student shall on completion of the course

- show good direction towards the ability to have a dialogue with other artists.

Course content

The content of the course is based on the individual student's needs. Together with the faculty management the student makes an individual study plan in which is placed strong emphasis on the student's needs and vision for musical development and direction.

Course design

The course can be carried out in the form of individual lessons, group lessons, seminars, workshops/master classes and individual work (practicing, preparations).

Assessment

Examination of the course is arranged through continuous assessment and tests/exams. Examination rules, such as examination requirements and mark limits, shall be communicated to the student at the beginning of the course.

Re-examination of the course shall be offered in close connection to the regular examination.

The examiner, in consultation with Disability Support Services, may deviate from the regular form of examination in order to provide a permanently disabled student with a form of examination equivalent to that of a student without a disability.

General and School of Music entrance test.
