The syllabus was approved by Education Committee of the Performane and Church Music Department on 2017-11-29 to be valid from 2017-11-29, autumn semester 2017.

General Information

Compulsory course in Bachelor's Programme in Music: Arranging/Composition Jazz Style, first cycle 180 credits.

Language of instruction: Swedish

Main field of studies

Music

Learning outcomes

The aim of the course is to enable students to acquire the following knowledge and skills on completion of the course.

Knowledge and understanding

The student shall on completion of the course

• have a basic ability to produce well working music material for rehearsals and concert situations occurring in the projects.

The student shall on completion of the course

- have a basic ability to develop and critically assess own ideas and critically review own and others' viewpoints,
- have a basic ability to conceive, plan, carry out and take responsibility for own projects/concerts/events in different contexts,
- have a basic ability to, in front of varying music ensembles, make a personal presentation and a presentation of the own composition and/or arrangement,
- have a basic ability to write texts such as work comments and biographies in connection with concerts and presentations of different kinds and also
- have a basic ability to think and act flexibly and to adapt to changes and new circumstances.

Judgement and approach

The student shall on completion of the course

- have a basic ability to identify personal needs for skill development,
- have a basic ability to make assessments considering relevant artistic, social and ethical aspects and also
- have a basic understanding of the role of art in society.

Course content

The course can contain rehearsals and concerts with own arrangements/compositions and possible seminars connected to the project/projects.

Course design

The course is carried out in the form of seminars and individual work. Attendance is compulsory for projects within the education.

Assessment

Examination of the course is arranged through continuous assessment and tests/exams. Examination rules, such as examination requirements and mark limits, shall be communicated to the student at the beginning of the course.

Re-examination of the course shall be offered in close connection to the regular examination.

The examiner, in consultation with Disability Support Services, may deviate from the regular form of examination in order to provide a permanently disabled student with a form of examination equivalent to that of a student without a disability.
