Compulsory course in Bachelor's Programme in Church Music: first cycle 180 credits.

Learning outcomes

The aim of the course is to enable students to acquire the following knowledge and skills on completion of the course.

Knowledge and understanding

The student shall on completion of the course

- show good direction towards a well developed knowledge and understanding of the role and possibilities of music in different communities and contexts.

Competence and skills

The student shall on completion of the course

- show good direction towards the ability to smoothly combine and alternately use different musical skills- vocal, instrumental and theoretical- in different contexts, and
- show good direction towards the ability to critically reflect on the personal artistic approach in a wider artistic context.

Judgement and approach

The student shall on completion of the course

- show good direction towards a well developed ability to discuss the own professional future and need for skill development and
- show good direction towards the ability to co-operate with other artists.

Course content

Seminars within the field of church music.

Course design

The course is carried out in the form of group lessons, seminars, guest lectures, workshops/master classes and individual work (practicing, preparations).

Attendance: A minimum of 80%.

Assessment

Examination of the course is arranged through continuous assessment and exams/tests. Examination rules, such as examination requirements and mark limits, shall be communicated to the student at the beginning of the course.

Re-examination of the course shall be offered in close connection to the regular examination.

The examiner, in consultation with Disability Support Services, may deviate from the regular form of examination in order to provide a permanently disabled student with a form of examination equivalent to that of a student without a disability.
