Learning outcomes

The aim of the course is to enable students to acquire the following knowledge and skills on completion of the course.

Knowledge and understanding

The student shall on completion of the course

- have a basic ability for ensemble leading,
- in music-making, have a basic understanding of style and expressions in church music repertoire, preferably for children's choir, youth choir and adult choir,
- have basic experience of choir singing at a high artistic level and

• have a basic knowledge of the special methodology and psychology of children's choir and youth choir leading.

Competence and skills

The student shall on completion of the course

- have the ability to, at a basic level, study and carry out artistic assignments as an ensemble leader of adult choirs, youth choirs and children's choirs and also
- show the ability to analyse the personal artistic approach.

Judgement and approach

The student shall on completion of the course

• show the ability to have conversations with colleagues and fellow musicians.

Course content

Work including conducting technique, studying methods, score analysis, methodology and psychology for children's choir and youth choir. The course assumes approved result of earlier course MUUH66.

Course design

The independent practical work is supported by individual lessons and lessons in small or large groups. Seminars and master classes are also occurring.

Assessment

Examination of the course is arranged through continuous assessment and tests/exams. Examination rules, such as examination requirements and mark limits, shall be communicated to the student at the beginning of the course.

Re-examination of the course shall be offered in close connection to the regular examination.

The examiner, in consultation with Disability Support Services, may deviate from the regular form of examination in order to provide a permanently disabled student with a form of examination equivalent to that of a student without a disability.
