General Information

Compulsory course in Church Music, University Diploma 120 credits.

Learning outcomes

The aim of the course is to enable students to acquire the following knowledge and skills on completion of the course.

Knowledge and understanding

The student shall on completion of the course

• show good direction towards a basic knowledge and understanding of the role and possibilities of music in different communities and contexts.

Competence and skills

The student shall on completion of the course

- show good direction towards the ability to alternately use different musical skillsvocal, instrumental and theoretical- and also
- show good direction towards the ability to analyse the personal artistic approach.

Judgement and approach

The student shall on completion of the course

- show good direction towards a basic ability to discuss the own professional future and need for skill development and also
- show good direction towards the ability to have a conversations with colleagues and fellow musicians.

Course content

Placement in parish: taking part in and performing the tasks of a parish organist such as practicing for, and playing the organ at, church services and ordinances; preparation and implementation of choir rehearsals and performances; staff meetings and meetings with parishioners in different situations; administration.

Course design

The course is carried out in the form of placement. Attendance: A minimum of 80%.

Assessment

Active participation as well as placement report.

The examiner, in consultation with Disability Support Services, may deviate from the regular form of examination in order to provide a permanently disabled student with a form of examination equivalent to that of a student without a disability.

Grades

Marking scale: Fail, Pass.
