Learning outcomes

The aim of the course is to enable students to acquire the following knowledge and skills on completion of the course.

Knowledge and understanding

The student shall on completion of the course

- show a developed technical skill on the instrument and
- when playing, show a developed understanding of the style, expressions and improvisation formulas of the current repertoire.

Competence and skills

The student shall on completion of the course

- show the ability to independently, but together with others, study and carry out artistic assignments,
- show the ability to critically reflect on the personal artistic approach and that of fellow musicians and also
- show developed ability for musical interplay in different constellations and ensembles.

Judgement and approach

The student shall on completion of the course

• show the ability to have a constructive dialogue with other artists.

Course content

The course consists of ensemble related development processes.

Course design

The course mainly consists of group lessons in small and medium sized ensembles.

Attendance: A minimum of 80%.

Assessment

Examination of the course is arranged through continuous assessment, presentations and/or concerts. Examination rules, such as examination requirements and mark limits, shall be communicated to the student at the beginning of the course.

Re-examination of the course shall be offered in close connection to the regular examination.

The examiner, in consultation with Disability Support Services, may deviate from the regular form of examination in order to provide a permanently disabled student with a form of examination equivalent to that of a student without a disability.
