Details of approval

General Information

The course is offered as a freestanding course. It can normally be included in a first or second cycle degree.

- describe Danish pronunciation
- account for conditions of oral communication from a Danish perspective
- describe and identify different oral genres in Danish
- describe and identify different styles of oral conversation in different Danish environments

• express themselves in Danish in different situations of oral communication

• identify their need of further knowledge in the subject

Course content

The course consists of study of oral communication with regard to different oral genres, pronunciation, vocabulary and grammar. Major emphasis is placed on enabling students to actively practise their ability to speak Danish.

Course design

The teaching consists of exercises, lectures and 4-6 compulsory seminars.

Assessment

The assessment is continuous throughout the course and based on 4-5 home assignments, oral presentations in the context of teaching and an oral exam at the end of the course.

Grades

Marking scale: Fail, Pass, Pass with distinction.

Entry requirements

To be admitted to the course, students must have passed NODB11, An Introduction to Danish, 7.5 credits, or the equivalent.

Further information

- 1. The course requires good knowledge of Swedish.
- 2. It replaces NODB03 Oral Danish 7.5 credits. It is also included as a module in NODA13 Danish: Level 1. The credits allocated for course content that in whole or in part is commensurate with another course can only be credited once for a degree.
- 3. The course is offered at the Centre for Languages and Literature, Lund University.
