## **NOIB01, An Introduction to Icelandic, 7.5 credits**

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### **Details of approval**

The syllabus was approved by the programmes director by delegation from the pro-dean for first- and second-cycle studies on 2007-03-13 to be valid from 2007-03-13, autumn semester 2007.

### **General Information**

Subject: Nordic Languages

The course is offered as a single course. It can normally be included as part of a general degree at the undergraduate or graduate levels. With the approval of the relevant authenticating body, it can also be included in certain professional degrees.

### **Learning outcomes**

On completion of the course the student shall

#### **Knowledge and understanding**

- be able to give an account of the basic structural features of contemporary Icelandic (pronunciation, inflection and word formation, and syntax)
- be able to utilise the key vocabulary of simple everyday contemporary Icelandic

#### **Competence and skills**

- be able to read and translate simple Icelandic texts, with the help of dictionaries and other aids

- be able to write simple texts in coherent Icelandic, with the help of dictionaries and other aids.

## **Course content**

The course gives an introduction to contemporary Icelandic. Emphasis is placed on reading comprehension and vocabulary, and to a certain extent on written proficiency. The structure of the Icelandic language is also discussed.

## **Course design**

Teaching consists of exercises, lectures, and seminars. All elements involving proficiency are obligatory.

## **Assessment**

The following examination forms can occur: oral and/or written tests at the end of each sub-course, continuous assessment in the form of home assignments, essays and seminars.
