## **RUMM14, Romanian: Romanian Literature, 7.5 credits**

*Rumäniska: Rumänsk litteratur, 7,5 högskolepoäng*

Second Cycle / Avancerad nivå

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### **Details of approval**

The syllabus was approved by the programmes director by delegation from the pro-dean for first- and second-cycle studies on 2013-05-08 to be valid from 2013-05-08, autumn semester 2013.

### **General Information**

The course is a compulsory component of the Master of Arts programme in Language and Linguistics specialising in Romanian. It is also offered as a freestanding course and can be included as part of a first or second cycle degree.

### **Learning outcomes**

On completion of the course the students shall

#### **Knowledge and understanding**

- be able to account for Romanian literary history, its various periods and genres and key authors and works
- be able to account for Romanian literary texts of various styles and from various genres and periods

#### **Competence and skills**

- be able to independently discuss relevant issues taken from a selected problem area in Romanian literature

- be able to summarise and report a chosen problem area in Romanian literature

### **Judgement and approach**

- be able to relate to a general humanist tradition of learning through the selected problem area in Romanian literature.

### **Course content**

In consultation with the lecturer, students choose a selection of literary texts based on the knowledge of Romanian literature acquired on the course and address a problem area related to authorship, genre or stylistic register in a written assignment and minor written project.

### **Course design**

Teaching consists of seminars and supervised independent studies.

### **Assessment**

Assessment is based on a written assignment and final minor project.

### **Grades**

Marking scale: Fail, Pass, Pass with distinction.

### **Entry requirements**

To be admitted to the course, students must have passed 120 credits in Romanian (course RUMK01), or the equivalent.
