The syllabus was approved by the programmes director by delegation from the prodean for first- and second-cycle studies on 2007-06-18 to be valid from 2007-06-18, autumn semester 2007.

General Information

Subject: Russian

The course is offered as a single course. It can normally be included as part of a general degree at both the undergraduate and graduate levels.

Language of instruction: Swedish

Learning outcomes

On completion of the course the student shall

Knowledge and understanding

• be able to demonstrate in-depth knowledge of the history of Russian literature

Competence and skills

• be able to analyse fictional texts on the basis of their place in Russian literary history and to give these findings orally and in writing

Judgement and approach

- be able to analyse and give an account of how the power relationships of gender and ethnicity are reflected and discussed in Russian literature
- be able to reflect on the problems concerning the role of Russian literature in the creation of national identity.

Course content

The course contains an in-depth academic study of selected aspects of the history of Russian literature, the reading of fiction and a project.

The course consists of the following two sub-courses:

- 1. In-depth Theory Course, 10 credits,
- 2. Project, 5 credits.

Course design

Teaching consists of lectures and seminars of which some may be compulsory and be assessed.

Assessment

Examinations can take the following forms: oral and/or written examinations, written assignments, essay and compulsory assessed seminars.

Subcourses that are part of this course can be found in an appendix at the end of this document.

Grades

Marking scale: Fail, Pass, Pass with distinction.

To be awarded a Pass on the whole course the student shall have passed all subcourses. To be awarded a grade of Pass with Distinction on the whole course the student shall have achieved the grade of Pass with Distinction for at least 10 higher education credits on the course and the grade of Pass on the remainder of the course.

Entry requirements

To be eligible for the course requires RYSB11 or RYSB12 or the equivalent.
