General Information

Subject: French studies

The course is offered as a freestanding course. It can normally be included as part of a general first- or second-cycle degree.

Language of instruction: French

Main field of studies

French

Depth of study relative to the degree requirements

G1F, First cycle, has less than 60 credits in first-cycle course/s as entry requirements

Learning outcomes

On completion of the course students shall

Knowledge and understanding

- be able to give a general description of the development and status of the European Union in the world
- be able to give an account of the principal objectives, methods of working and areas of application of the main EU institutions (the European Commission, the Council of the European Union, the European Parliament, the European Court of Justice etc.)

Competence and skills

- be able to give an account of the contents of the new constitution and be able to argue either for or against the changes it entails

Judgement and approach

- be able to critically approach issues concerning ethnicity and diversity in the context of the enlargement of the European Union.

Course content

The course examines the European Union at a basic level. Included in the course is the discussion in French of the history of the EU, its institutions, and the consequences of its enlargement and of joint economic and social policies for the member states. In addition to the reading of texts, the study of other media is included in the course.

Course design

Teaching consists of lectures, classes, group exercises and oral presentations in French.

Assessment

The assessment is based on a written exam.

Grades

Marking scale: Fail, Pass, Pass with distinction.

Entry requirements

To be admitted to the course students must have passed FRAA01 or the equivalent.

1. The course is offered at the Centre for Languages and Literature, Lund University.
