# SPAA03, Spanish: Level 3, 30 credits

Spanska: Fördjupningskurs, 30 högskolepoäng First Cycle / Grundnivå

## Details of approval

The syllabus is an old version, approved by the programmes director by delegation from the pro-dean for first- and second-cycle studies on 2007-03-30 and was valid from 2007-03-30, autumn semester 2007.

### General Information

The course is offered as a single course. It can normally be included as part of a general degree at both the undergraduate and graduate levels.

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### Learning outcomes

On completion of the course the student shall

### Knowledge and understanding

- be able to describe methods and concepts in current Spanish literature and linguistics
- be able to give an account of literary texts from Latin America and/or Spain, primarily from the 20th century
- demonstrate further in-depth knowledge of the structure of Spanish
- demonstrate advanced knowledge of certain specially studied thematic areas in the field of Spanish-speaking cultures

### Competence and skills

- be able to summarise, analyse and discuss themes within current Spanish literature and linguistics
- be able to use a rich, varied and suitably appropriate language both in speech and writing
- be able to use various resources in information technology and evaluate information from a variety of sources that is relevant to the subject

### Judgement and approach

- be able to discuss the place of linguistics and literary studies in the academic world
- demonstrate an ability for critical self-evaluation
- be able to relate to a general humanist scholarly tradition.

#### Course content

The course provides advanced knowledge and understanding of language, literature and society in Spain and Latin America. This involves, in part, a scholarly approach to language and literature and, in part, an independent, thematic study in the field of Spanish-speaking cultures. Throughout the course practice is continued in oral and written proficiency.

The course consists of the following four sub-courses:

- 1. The History of Spanish Literature, as a Scholarly Discipline, 7.5 credits,
- 2. Spanish Linguistics, as a Scholarly Discipline, 7.5 credits,
- 3. Thematic Course I, 7.5 credits,
- 4. Thematic Course II, 7.5 credits.

## Course design

Teaching may take the following forms: lectures and group work. All elements involving proficiency are obligatory.

### Assessment

Examinations can take the following forms: written and oral examinations and home assignments.

Subcourses that are part of this course can be found in an appendix at the end of this document.

### Grades

Marking scale: Fail, Pass, Pass with distinction.

To be awarded a Pass on the whole course the student shall have passed all subcourses. To be awarded a grade of Distinction on the whole course the student shall have achieved the grade of Distinction for at least 15 higher education credits on the In Spanish sub-courses the grades 1-5 are used in which 1 is the lowest and 5 the highest grade. A grade of 1 is equivalent to Fail.

### Entry requirements

To be eligible for the course requires the successful completion of SPAA02 Spanish, Level 2, or the equivalent.

### Further information

- 1. With the exception of the degree project, this course replaces SPA603.
- 2. Sub-courses 1 and 2 are the equivalent of sub-courses 1 and 2 in SPAK01.
- 3. The points allocated for course content that in whole or in part is commensurate with another course can only be credited once for a degree. For further details see the current registration information and other relevant documentation.
- 4. The course is intended both for students who intend to join the teaching profession and for those who have other aims.
