**SPAA22, Spanish: Level 2, 30 credits**  
*Spanska: Föreläsning, 30 högskolepoäng*  
First Cycle / Grundnivå

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### Details of approval

The syllabus is an old version, approved by the programmes director by delegation from the pro-dean for first- and second-cycle studies on 2013-09-11 and was last revised on 2014-12-12 by the pro-dean for first-cycle studies at the Faculties of Humanities and Theology. The revised syllabus applied from 2014-12-12, autumn semester 2014.

### General Information

The course is offered as a freestanding course. It can normally be included in a first or second cycle degree.

### Learning outcomes

On completion of the course, the students shall be able to

#### Knowledge and understanding

- describe essential features of the structure of Spanish and discuss contrastive differences between Spanish and Swedish
- account for Spanish and Latin-American literary texts from the 20th century
- provide a basic account of Spanish and/or Latin-American film
- provide a basic account of Spanish linguistics

#### Competence and skills

- use Spanish with a level of lexical and grammatical accuracy that does not impede communication
- supported by aids write a coherent and relatively correct Spanish text
- complete a minor independent research project within a set timeframe

### **Judgement and approach**

- identify the personal need of further knowledge in Spanish
- discuss and take positions on issues of gender, ethnicity, cultural encounters and cultural diversity from different literary and linguistic points of view

### **Course content**

The course provides students with specialised knowledge of language, literature, film and society in Spain and Latin America. Furthermore, it provides students with further training in oral and written proficiency.

The course consists of the following modules:

1. Latin America? text and society, 6 credits,
2. Spanish linguistics, 6 credits,
3. Spanish and Latin-American film, 6 credits,
4. Spanish grammar with exercises, 6 credits,
5. Academic writing, 6 credits.

### **Course design**

The teaching consists of lectures and group exercises.

Attendance is compulsory in module 5, Academic writing.

### **Assessment**

1. Latin America? text and society: 2 written assignments, 1 written exam,
2. Spanish linguistics: 2 written assignments, 1 written exam, 1 oral presentation,
3. Spanish and Latin-American film, 2 written assignments, 1 written exam,
4. Spanish grammar with exercises: 2 written assignments, 1 written exam, 1 oral presentation,
5. Academic writing: 1 short paper, 1 oral critical review.

## Grades

Marking scale: Fail, Pass, Pass with distinction.

To be awarded a grade of Pass on the whole course, the student must have been awarded this grade on all modules. To be awarded the grade of Pass with Distinction, students must have been awarded this grade on 18 credits and a grade of Pass on the remaining credits.

Modules in Spanish are graded in accordance with a scale of 1 to 5, in which 1 is the lowest and 5 is the highest grade. The grade 1 corresponds to the grade Fail. 2.

## Entry requirements

To be admitted to the course, the student must have passed course SPAA01: Spanish Level 1, or the equivalent

1. The course completely replaces SPAA21: Spanish Level 2, 31-60 credits.
2. The credits allocated for course content that in whole or in part is commensurate with another course can only be credited once for a degree. For further details see the current registration information and other relevant documentation.
