SPAB01, Spanish: Beginners' Course - Level I, 15 credits

Details of approval

The syllabus was approved by the programmes director by delegation from the prodean for first- and second-cycle studies on 2007-03-30 to be valid from 2007-03-30, autumn semester 2007.

General Information

The course is offered as a single course. It can normally be included as part of a general degree at both the undergraduate and graduate levels. With the approval of the relevant authenticating body, it can also be included in certain professional degrees.

Language of instruction: Spanish and Swedish

Learning outcomes

On completion of the course the student shall

Knowledge and understanding

- be aware of and be able to apply the most common grammatical structures, and their terminology, in Spanish
- be able to describe in Spanish some of the most important features of Spanish and Latin-American cultures and to compare them with conditions in Sweden

Competence and skills

- have mastered a basic vocabulary of the most frequent words and expressions in Spanish
- be able to express him/herself in simple spoken and written Spanish.

Course content

The course provides access to an elementary vocabulary and knowledge of basic grammatical structures through a study of simple Spanish texts that are cultural in nature. The course includes basic practice in Spanish pronunciation and simple oral and written exercises.

Course design

Teaching may take the following forms: lectures and group work. All elements involving proficiency are obligatory.

Assessment

Examinations can take the following forms: written and oral examinations and home assignments.

Grades

Marking scale: Fail, Pass, Pass with distinction.
