Details of approval

The syllabus was approved by the programmes director by delegation from the pro-dean for first- and second-cycle studies on 2007-03-30 to be valid from 2007-03-30, autumn semester 2007.

General Information

The course is offered as a single course. It can normally be included as part of a general degree at both the undergraduate and graduate levels. With the approval of the relevant authenticating body, it can also be included in certain professional degrees.

Language of instruction: Swedish and Spanish

Main field of studies

Spanish

Depth of study relative to the degree requirements

G1F, First cycle, has less than 60 credits in first-cycle course/s as entry requirements

Learning outcomes

On completion of the course the student shall

Knowledge and understanding

- have acquired a sufficient knowledge of Spanish and general grammar to be able to study a general course at university or university college that requires upper secondary school qualifications in the language
- be able to describe in Spanish some of the most important features of Spanish and Latin-American cultures and to compare them with conditions in Sweden.

Competence and skills

- be able to express him/herself in basic spoken and written Spanish with sufficient fluency to be able to study the subject at university level.

Course content

The course provides access to an extended vocabulary and a wider knowledge of grammatical structures through the study of texts that are primarily cultural in nature. In addition to an in-depth study of texts, the course also includes practice in written and spoken Spanish in communicative contexts.

Course design

Teaching may take the following forms: lectures and group work. All elements involving proficiency are obligatory.

Assessment

Examinations can take the following forms: written and oral examinations and home assignments.

Grades

Marking scale: Fail, Pass, Pass with distinction.

Entry requirements

To be eligible for the course requires the successful completion of SPAB01 Spanish, Beginners Course I, or the equivalent.
