# SPAB05, Spanish: Thematic Course I, 7.5 credits

Spanska: Temakurs I, 7,5 högskolepoäng First Cycle / Grundnivå

## Details of approval

The syllabus was approved by The pro-dean for First-Cycle Studies at the Faculties of Humanities and Theology on 2009-05-04 and was last revised on 2022-06-08. The revised syllabus applies from 2022-06-08, spring semester 2023.

#### General Information

The course is offered as a freestanding course. It can normally be included in a first or second cycle degree.

Language of instruction: Spanish

In some components, where the lecturer considers it to be appropriate, Swedish may also be used as a language of instruction.

## Learning outcomes

On completion of the course, students shall be able to:

#### Knowledge and understanding

- give an account of literary texts from Latin America and/or Spain, primarily from the twentieth century
- give an account of advanced knowledge in certain specialised thematic areas,

#### Competence and skills

- independently summarise, analyse and discuss themes in present-day Spanishspeaking literature,
- use a rich and varied discourse in speech and writing that is appropriate to the situation,

### Judgement and approach

• evaluate and take a critical approach to information from various sources.

#### Course content

The course provides students with specialised knowledge of language, literature, film and society in Spain or Latin America. It contains an independent thematic study in the area of Spanish-speaking culture. The course provides further practice in oral and written proficiency.

### Course design

The course is mainly a reading course, which means that the student may read texts alone before they are presented and discussed in three or four seminars.

The course is offered on campus or via distance learning. In its online form, the course uses a digital learning platform. Students are required to participate according to these conditions, and to have access to a computer with an internet connection. The department will provide information about the technical requirements.

#### Assessment

The course is assessed through 1 written take-home examination, 1 oral presentation.

The examiner, in consultation with Disability Support Services, may deviate from the regular form of examination in order to provide a permanently disabled student with a form of examination equivalent to that of a student without a disability.

Subcourses that are part of this course can be found in an appendix at the end of this document.

#### Grades

Marking scale: Fail, Pass, Pass with distinction.

For the grade of Pass, students must pass both the take-home examination and the oral presentation. Pass with distinction requires a result of pass with distinction in both the take-home examination and the oral presentation.

# Entry requirements

To be admitted to the course, students must have successfully completed SPAA20, Spanish, Level 2, or the equivalent.
