General Information

Subject: Spanish

The course is offered as a freestanding course. It can normally be included in a first or second cycle degree.

- describe important features of present-day Latin American film
- seek information about the Latin American countries concerned and their history in Spanish
- recognise basic concepts of film studies in Spanish

Competence and skills

- execute a simple film analysis in written and spoken Spanish
- identify basic Latin American language variation

Judgement and approach

- identify different perspectives on Latin American film.

Course content

The course is a basic course in Spanish dealing with a number of representative 21st century Latin American films. The works examined are primarily placed in relation to the political and social context of the relevant country, but the specific conditions and features such as the artistic form of the film are also addressed.

Course design

The teaching consists of 8-10 lectures including group work. The teaching is compulsory.

Assessment

The assessment is based on 2-3 written assignments and a written exam.

Subcourses that are part of this course can be found in an appendix at the end of this document.

Grades

Marking scale: Fail, Pass, Pass with distinction.

The grades awarded are Fail, Pass or Pass with Distinction.

Entry requirements

General requirements and studies equivalent of courses English 6 and Spanish 3 from Swedish Upper Secondary School.
