General Information

The course is offered as a freestanding course. It can normally be included in a first or second cycle degree.

Course content

The course is based on the study of simple texts in Spanish mainly dealing with culture. The texts are used to enable students to acquire a central and elementary vocabulary and knowledge about the Hispanophone world. Furthermore, the includes exercises in understanding spoken Spanish and using basic grammatical structures and vocabulary in speech and writing.

The course consists of the following modules:

1. Basic Spanish Language Proficiency, 7.5 credits,

3. Spanish Language Proficiency, 7.5 credits.

Course design

The teaching consists of lectures and group exercises.

Assessment

The assessment of module 1 is based on a written invigilated exam.

The assessment of module 2 is based on a written invigilated exam and an oral exam.

The examiner, in consultation with Disability Support Services, may deviate from the regular form of examination in order to provide a permanently disabled student with a form of examination equivalent to that of a student without a disability.

Grades

Marking scale: Fail, Pass, Pass with distinction.

For a grade of Pass, students must have been awarded at least a grade of Pass on both modules. For a grade of Pass with Distinction, students must also have been awarded a grade of Pass with Distinction on module 2.
