Details of approval

The syllabus was approved by The pro-dean for First-Cycle Studies at the Faculties of Humanities and Theology on 2019-07-02 to be valid from 2019-07-02, spring semester 2020.

General Information

Subject: Spanish

The course is offered as a freestanding course. It can normally be included in a first or second cycle degree.

Language of instruction: Spanish and Swedish

Main field of studies

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Depth of study relative to the degree requirements

G1F, First cycle, has less than 60 credits in first-cycle course/s as entry requirements

Learning outcomes

On completion of the course, the students shall be able to

Knowledge and understanding

- describe a selection of representative grammatical phenomena in Spanish
- describe the main contrastive difficulties for a Swedish student of these grammatical phenomena

Competence and skills

- in speech and in writing, independently use essentially correct Spanish in terms of characteristic grammatical phenomena

- using their own examples, account for contrasting differences between Spanish or Swedish language structure with regard to the language phenomena in question

Judgement and approach

- take a critical position on the scholarly view within Spanish as a subject with regard to the required reading.

Course content

The course is a freestanding course on Spanish grammar and covers a number of topics such as the different meanings of 'se' and the variation in the use of the subjunctive.

Course design

The course includes lectures and seminar discussions. Attendance at a minimum of 80% of the lectures and seminar discussions is compulsory unless special circumstances apply.

Students who have been unable to participate due to circumstances such as accidents, illness or similar will be offered the opportunity to compensate for or re-take compulsory components. This also applies to students who have missed classes because of activities as a student representative. In other cases, there will be no opportunity to compensate for compulsory components.

Assessment

Assessment of the course is based on a written assignment and a written invigilated exam.

The examiner, in consultation with Disability Support Services, may deviate from the regular form of examination in order to provide a permanently disabled student with a form of examination equivalent to that of a student without a disability.

Subcourses that are part of this course can be found in an appendix at the end of this document.

Grades

Marking scale: Fail, Pass, Pass with distinction.

For the grade of Pass, students must have been awarded at least the grade of Pass on both of the assessed components. For the grade of Pass with Distinction, students must also have been awarded the grade of Pass with Distinction on the written invigilated exam.

Entry requirements

To be admitted to the course, students must have successfully completed Spanish: Level 1, or the equivalent.
