SPAB15, Spanish: Spanish Grammar, 7.5 credits

Details of approval

The syllabus was approved by The pro-dean for First-Cycle Studies at the Faculties of Humanities and Theology on 2021-11-01 to be valid from 2021-11-01, spring semester 2022.

General Information

The course is offered as a freestanding course. It can normally be included in a first or second cycle degree.

Language of instruction: Swedish and Spanish

The course includes contrastive study of Spanish and Swedish.

Learning outcomes

On completion of the course, the students shall be able to:

Knowledge and understanding

- describe the main features of Spanish language structure
- describe certain contrasting differences between Spanish and Swedish language structure

Competence and skills

• supported by aids, write a situation-adapted and, for the most part, correct text in Spanish

Judgement and approach

- provide perspectives on the conditions of Spanish language society
- take a critical position on source material and their own knowledge acquisition

Course content

The course Spanish Grammar provides theoretical knowledge of the structure of the Spanish language and offers practical exercises to construct sentences and brief texts. The course focuses on contrastive ability that is trained practically through translation between Spanish and Swedish.

Course design

Teaching consists of lectures and group work. The course includes a compulsory assignment in the form of an oral presentation.

Unless special circumstances apply, students must also attend at least 80% of the lectures and complete all group assignments. Students who have been unable to participate due to circumstances such as accidents, illness or similar will be offered the opportunity to compensate for or re-take compulsory components. This also applies to students who have missed classes due to activities as a student representative. In other cases, there will be no opportunity to compensate for compulsory components.

Assessment

Assessment of the course is based on a written assignment and a written invigilated

The examiner, in consultation with Disability Support Services, may deviate from the regular form of examination in order to provide a permanently disabled student with a form of examination equivalent to that of a student without a disability.

Grades

Marking scale: Fail, Pass, Pass with distinction.

For the grade of Pass, students must have been awarded at least the grade of Pass on the written examination and at least 65 points out of 100 on the written assignment. For the grade of Pass with Distinction, students must have been awarded the grade of Pass with Distinction on the written examination and at least 80 credits out of 100 on the written assignment.

Entry requirements

General requirements and studies equivalent of course Spanish 3 from Swedish Upper Secondary School.

- 1. The course is offered at the Centre for Languages and Literature, Lund University.
- 2. The course overlaps with and is normally coordinated with Spanish: Level 1, Module 4: Spanish Grammar.
- 3. The credits allocated for course content that in whole or in part is commensurate with another course can only be credited once for a degree. For further details, see the current registration information and other relevant documentation.
- 4. A Pass on the written assignment is valid for two years for an incomplete course. Thereafter, the student must submit a new written assignment to receive a final grade on the course.
