## SPAF02, Spanish: Spanish Linguistics as a Scholarly Discipline, 7.5 credits

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### Details of approval

The syllabus was approved by The pro-dean for First-Cycle Studies at the Faculties of Humanities and Theology on 2019-07-02 to be valid from 2019-07-02, spring semester 2020.

### General Information

The course is offered as a freestanding course. It can normally be included in a first or second cycle degree.

### Learning outcomes

On completion of the course, the students shall be able to

#### Knowledge and understanding

- provide a nuanced description of methods and concepts in current Spanish linguistics
- provide a specialised account of the structure of Spanish
- account for some current research issues in Spanish linguistics

### Competence and skills

- independently summarise, analyse and discuss, in both speech and writing, themes within current Spanish linguistics
- use correct and nuanced Spanish adapted to the situation in speech and writing

### **Judgement and approach**

- take a critical position on the scholarly approach in Spanish studies, particularly taking into account ethical issues such as gender and ethnicity, and research ethics

### **Course content**

The course is a freestanding course in Spanish linguistics and covers a number of themes such as verb semantics and conceptualisation of nuances in linguistic structure.

### **Course design**

The course includes lectures and seminar discussions. Attendance at at least 80% of these components is compulsory unless special circumstances apply.

Students who have been unable to participate due to circumstances such as accidents, illness or similar will be offered the opportunity to compensate for or re-take compulsory components. This also applies to students who have missed classes because of activities as a student representative. In other cases, there will be no opportunity to compensate for compulsory components.

### **Assessment**

Assessment of the course is based on four written assignments, an oral presentation and an oral exam.

The examiner, in consultation with Disability Support Services, may deviate from the regular form of examination in order to provide a permanently disabled student with a form of examination equivalent to that of a student without a disability.

### **Grades**

Marking scale: Fail, Pass, Pass with distinction.

For a grade of Pass, the student must have been awarded at least this grade for all the assessed components. For a grade of Pass with Distinction, the student must also have been awarded a grade of Pass with Distinction on at least half of the assessed components.

### **Entry requirements**

To be admitted to the course, the student must have successfully completed Spanish: Level 2, or the equivalent.
