SPDA02, Spanish: Practical Spanish Didactics II, 7.5 credits *Spanska: Praktisk spansk didaktik II, 7,5 högskolepoäng* First Cycle / Grundnivå

Details of approval

The syllabus was approved by the programmes director by delegation from the pro-dean for first- and second-cycle studies on 2012-11-21 and was last revised on 2023-06-05 by The pro-dean for First-Cycle Studies at the Faculties of Humanities and Theology. The revised syllabus applies from 2023-06-05, autumn semester 2023.

General Information

The course is offered as a freestanding course. It can normally be included in a general qualification for both first and second-cycle studies.

Language of instruction: Swedish and Spanish

Main field of studies

Spanish

Learning outcomes

On completion of the course, the students shall be able to:

Knowledge and understanding

- account for some key concepts in language didactics and for certain theories associated with language didactics up to the present day,
- account for different methods of teaching key aspects of Spanish language and culture on advanced upper secondary school courses in Spanish

Competence and skills

- choose teaching methods and study resources for a certain component and a specific group in advanced upper secondary school courses in Spanish and justify those choices
- use solidly supported arguments to discuss the advantages and shortcomings of

- different teaching methods
- plan and simulate a teaching component intended for later stages of upper secondary school courses in a relaxed and correct way, using terminology that is appropriate for the classroom situation

Judgement and approach

- assess and discuss the efficacy of different teaching methods
- identify and assess their own need of knowledge in the area Spanish didactics

Course content

SPDA02 is an independent continuation of SPDA01 aiming to provide students with practical knowledge and a certain degree of experience of teaching Spanish on advanced upper secondary school courses. The course also provides students with knowledge of language didactics as a research field and stresses the connection between theory and classroom practice.

Course design

The teaching consists of: lectures and group exercises. Students must attend at least 80% of the lectures and group exercises, unless

special circumstances apply. Apart from the assessed components, the course includes two compulsory assignments:

1 written assignment

1 oral presentation

The opportunity to compensate for or resit compulsory components will be offered to students who have been unable to participate due to circumstances out of their control such as accidents, illness or similar. This also applies to students who have missed teaching sessions because of duties as a student representative. There are otherwise no opportunities to compensate for compulsory components.

Assessment

The assessment is based on an oral presentation and an invigilated written exam.

The examiner, in consultation with Disability Support Services, may deviate from the regular form of examination in order to provide a permanently disabled student with a form of examination equivalent to that of a student without a disability.

Grades

Marking scale: Fail, Pass, Pass with distinction.

For a grade of Pass on the whole course, the student must have been awarded this grade on the oral presentation and the invigilated written exam. For a grade of Pass

with Distinction on the whole course, the student must have been awarded this grade on the oral presentation and on the invigilated written exam.

Entry requirements

To be admitted to the course, the student must have passed course SPAA01: Level 1, or have equivalent knowledge.
