Details of approval

The syllabus is an old version, approved by The Nursing, Radiography, and Reproductive, Perinatal and Sexual Health Programmes Board on 2018-11-21 and was valid from 2021-01-25, spring semester 2021.

General Information

The course is included that a compulsory course in The Specialist Nursing Programme, specialisation psychiatric care 60 credits, but can also be read as a freestanding course.

Some course components may be in English.

Learning outcomes

Knowledge and understanding

On completion of the course, students shall be able to

- identify and distinguish different types of anxiety conditions their nursing and treatment,
- identify and distinguish common child psychiatry states their nursing and treatment,
- explain relationships between drug effects and abstinenssymtom and suggest acute and long-term nursing and treatment efforts at abuse.

Competence and skills

On completion of the course, students shall be able to

- argue for and justify the use of evidence-based psychiatric nursing and treatment
- based on a kunskapsperspektiv discuss the relationships between mental illness and drug abuses.

Judgement and approach

On completion of the course, students shall be able to

• based on an ethical and person-oriented holistic approach argue for and against different nursing and treatment efforts.

Course content

Child psychiatry Substance abuse Psychiatric nursing Psychopharmacology Psychological and psychosocial treatment methods Anxiety syndromes

Course design

The different working methods include individual work, group work, peer review, skills training, seminars and lectures.

Assessment

All assessment is carried out individually, based on established criteria. One regular exam and two resits are organised for each exam/course component. Students who do not achieve a Pass grade during any of these instances have the opportunity to take additional examinations. A student who has failed an examination twice is entitled to request that another examiner be appointed by the programme director or equivalent.

In the case of a resit, an individual exam may replace a group exam.

The examiner, in consultation with Disability Support Services, may deviate from the regular form of examination in order to provide a permanently disabled student with a form of examination equivalent to that of a student without a disability.

Grades

Marking scale: Fail, Pass. For a pass on the course, the student must have passed all the assessed components.

Entry requirements

- Swedish professional status qualification as nurse and Degree of Bachelor of Science in Nursing with 180 credits including an individual assignment about 15 credits or equivalent
- Passed knowledge in Swedish and English that corresponds the requirements for general entry requirements at first cycle level
