Details of approval

The syllabus is an old version, approved by The Nursing, Radiography, and Reproductive, Perinatal and Sexual Health Programmes Board on 2020-10-28 and was valid from 2020-10-28, spring semester 2021.

General Information

The course is included as a compulsory course in the Radiography programme (180 credits) and the Nursing programme (180 credits). It complies with the guidelines of the Higher Education Ordinance (SFS 1993:100 with later amendments).

Some course components may be in English.

Learning outcomes

Knowledge and understanding

On completion of the course, students shall be able to

• based on current knowledge, systematically compare forms of, and barriers to, learning during clinical training (Swedish abbreviation VFU).

Course content

Current learning theory related to supervision and learning during clinical training.

Course design

The different working methods include Individual work, lectures, group assignments and seminars. The learning activities, course content and formative assessments are based on learning outcomes and assessment criteria.

Absence from compulsory learning activities can be compensated for by other learning activities.

Assessment

All assessment is carried out individually, based on established criteria. One regular exam and two resits are organised for each exam/course component. Students who do not achieve a Pass grade during any of these instances have the opportunity to take additional examinations. Students who fail in two examination sessions can request a change of examiner. In the case of a resit, an individual exam may replace a group exam.

The examiner, in consultation with Disability Support Services, may deviate from the regular form of examination in order to provide a permanently disabled student with a form of examination equivalent to that of a student without a disability.

Grades

Marking scale: Fail, Pass.

To pass the course, it is required that all tests/components are passed and all compulsory learning activities are completed.

Entry requirements

General and courses corresponding to the following Swedish Upper Secondary School Programs: Mathematics 2, Science 2, and Social Studies 1b/1a1+1a2. (Biology 1+Chemistry 1+Physics 1a/1b1+1b2 equals Science 1+2)
