General Information

The course is offered as a free-standing course and is an elective component of the Master of Arts programme in Language and Linguistics.

On completion of the course the student shall

Knowledge and understanding

- be able to provide an in-depth account of Swedish/Scandinavian grammar and describe current research and development work in grammar
- be able to compile and discuss advanced grammar literature in an informed manner

Competence and skills

- be able to analyse key problems in grammar in a sophisticated manner
- independently be able to identify and formulate relevant issues in grammar

Judgement and approach

• be able to problematise and critically approach current research on grammar.

Course content

The course provides advanced study of Swedish/Scandinavian grammar requiring previous second-cycle courses including grammar. The specific course content is determined in consultation with the examiner and with regard to the interests and wishes of the students.

Course design

Teaching consists of supervised independent study.

Assessment

The assessment is based on a take-home exam.

Students normally have two opportunities for examination on the course.

Grades

Marking scale: Fail, Pass, Pass with distinction.

Entry requirements

To be admitted to the course students must have successfully completed second-cycle courses in generative grammar or Swedish/Scandinavian grammar.
