UKRB02, Ukrainian: Beginners' Course II, 15 credits Ukrainska: Nybörjarkurs II, 15 högskolepoäng

First Cycle / Grundnivå

Details of approval

The syllabus was approved by The pro-dean for First-Cycle Studies at the Faculties of Humanities and Theology on 2023-06-12 to be valid from 2023-09-01, spring semester 2024.

General Information

The course is offered as a freestanding course. It can normally be included in a general qualification for both first and second-cycle studies.

Language of instruction: Swedish and English Teaching is conducted in English or Swedish and Ukrainian.

Learning outcomes

On completion of the course, the students shall be able to:

Knowledge and understanding

- identify key declension patterns in Ukrainian,
- understand and give an account of the contents in simplified Ukrainian texts on a level corresponding to CEFR (Common European Framework of Reference left Languages) A2,

Competence and skills

- read simplified Ukrainian texts aloud with correct pronunciation that allows for good comprehension,
- master a vocabulary sufficient to be able to communicate in most everyday situations,

- describe the contents of spoken Ukrainian that is presented slowly and clearly and deals with familiar subjects,
- apply key Ukrainian declension patterns and constructions in speech and writing,
- write simple texts in Ukrainian using the most basic Ukrainian writing rules and grammar,

Judgement and approach

• critically review, discuss and take a position on linguistic and cultural norms.

Course content

The course is based on a study of simplified texts and dialogues in Ukrainian with a further study of vocabulary and basic grammatical structures. The course contains communicative and simple written exercises based on everyday situations. The course aims to provide both language proficiency training and advanced knowledge of the Ukrainian language, society and everyday life.

The course consists of three modules:

- 1. Elementary Ukrainian Grammar II, 7.5 credits,
- 2. Communicative Ukrainian II, 7.5 credits.

Course design

The teaching consists of lectures, teaching sessions and exercises.

Both modules include compulsory components:

Module 1: 3-6 compulsory written assignments.

Module 2: 3-6 compulsory written assignments.

Opportunities to compensate for compulsory components are offered in consultation with the course director.

Assessment

Module 1 is assessed through a written exam.

Module 2 is assessed through an oral exam.

The examiner, in consultation with Disability Support Services, may deviate from the regular form of examination in order to provide a permanently disabled student with a form of examination equivalent to that of a student without a disability.

Grades

Marking scale: Fail, Pass, Pass with distinction.

For the grade of Pass on the whole course, the student must have been awarded at least this grade on both modules. For the grade of Pass with Distinction on the whole course, the student must in addition have been awarded this grade on both modules.

Entry requirements

To be admitted to the course, students must have completed Ukrainian: Beginners' Course I (UKRB01) or the equivalent.
