### **Details of approval**

The syllabus was approved by The pro-dean for First-Cycle Studies at the Faculties of Humanities and Theology on 2017-01-26 to be valid from 2017-01-26, spring semester 2017.

### **General Information**

The course is included in the Master's programme in Secondary Education offered jointly by Lund and Kristianstad universities.

### **Learning outcomes**

On completion of the course, the students shall be able to

#### **Knowledge and understanding**

- provide a basic account of the grammatical structure of Modern Standard Chinese
- describe some of most important literary works from China in the 20th century
- identify teaching methods in Chinese that are appropriate to the target group

### **Competence and skills**

- read, translate into Swedish, and summarise simple fiction and non-fiction texts in Standard Chinese
- make themselves understood in Standard Chinese in discussions on selected topics such as literature, geography, history and politics
- predict and correct common syntactic errors among Swedish learners of Standard Chinese
- plan and implement efficient and interesting classroom activities

### **Judgement and approach**

- assess their own need of further knowledge and professional development in the subject
- reflect on learners' expectations, difficulties and development in the target language
- reflect on their own ability to provide feedback

### **Course content**

The course is based on reading and grammatical analysis of commented fiction and non-fiction texts in Chinese within areas such as political science, economics and international affairs. Students practise listening comprehension and oral and written presentations in all modules through e.g. group discussions, written exercise assignments and film screenings. The course also consists of a series of lectures, exercises and seminars aiming to introduce the students to the profession of teaching Standard Chinese.

The course consists of the following modules:

1. Modern Chinese Non-Fiction, 7.5 credits,
2. Conversation 5, 5.5 credits,
3. Modern Chinese Literature, 7.5 credits,
4. Conversation 6, 5 credits,
5. Subject-Specific Didactics for Mandarin Chinese II, 5 credits.

### **Course design**

The teaching consists of lectures, group exercises and seminars. Attendance is compulsory at the group exercises (2?3) and seminars (2?3) in module 5.

### **Assessment**

The assessment of module 1 is based on an invigilated written exam.  
The assessment of module 2 is based on an oral exam.  
The assessment of module 3 is based on an invigilated written exam  
The assessment of module 4 is based on an oral exam.  
The assessment of module 5 is based on a take-home exam and a paper.

*The examiner, in consultation with Disability Support Services, may deviate from the regular form of examination in order to provide a permanently disabled student with a form of examination equivalent to that of a student without a disability.*

## **Grades**

Marking scale: Fail, Pass, Pass with distinction.

For a grade of Pass on the whole course, the student must have been awarded this grade on all modules. For a grade of Pass with Distinction on the whole course, the student must have been awarded this grade on modules 3, 4 and 5.

## **Entry requirements**

To be admitted to the course, student must have passed at least 22.5 credits of course ÄKIA12, or the equivalent.
