Details of approval

The syllabus was approved by The pro-dean for First-Cycle Studies at the Faculties of Humanities and Theology on 2018-10-29 to be valid from 2018-10-29, autumn semester 2018.

General Information

The course is included in the Master's programme in Secondary Education offered by Lund University.

Language of instruction: Swedish and Spanish

Learning outcomes

On completion of the course, the students shall be able to

Knowledge and understanding

- describe important features of the geography and twentieth-century history of Spanish-speaking countries describe the fundamental features of Spanish literary development during the twentieth century
- describe the main features of the structure of Spanish and be able to describe certain contrastive differences between Spanish and Swedish
- account for basic methods and concepts of relevance to the learning of Spanish
- identify and account for different didactic methods in the teaching of Spanish in schools

Competence and skills

- speak Spanish in such a way that it does not cause problems of understanding
- assisted by aids, write a more or less correct Spanish text adapted to everyday situations
- master central parts of Spanish grammar and Spanish vocabulary and be able to use this knowledge in speech and writing
- independently be able to use grammars and dictionaries when studying Spanish texts
- at a basic level reflect on didactic processes in a teaching situation in the subject

Judgement and approach

- in a certain field, suggest perspectives on Spanish society and compare it to Swedish conditions and be able to take a position on issues concerning ethnicity and cultural encounters, for example from the position of Spanish as a world language
- identify and assess their own need of knowledge.

Course content

The course provides students with general knowledge of language, literature and society in Spain and Latin America. Furthermore, the course provides practice in oral and written proficiency. The course also includes didactic seminars aiming to introduce the students to the future profession. The student will practice his or her ability to identify and account for didactic working methods and to reflect on didactic processes in a teaching situation in the subject.

The course consists of the following modules:

1. Spanish and Latin American Texts, 6 credits,
2. Texts on Twentieth-Century Spanish Society, 6 credits,
3. Texts on Twentieth-Century Latin American Society, 6 credits,
4. Spanish Twentieth-Century Literary Texts, 6 credits,
5. Spanish Grammar Including Exercises, 6 credits.

Course design

The teaching consists of: lectures and 1–3 group exercises per module.

Attendance at a minimum of 80% of the lectures and participation in all group exercises are compulsory unless there are special circumstances. Students who have been unable to participate due to circumstances such as accidents or sudden illness will be offered the opportunity to compensate for or retake compulsory components. This also applies to students who have missed teaching because of activities as a student representative. In other cases, there will be no opportunity to compensate for compulsory components.

Assessment

Module 1 is assessed on the basis of 1 written exam and 2-3 written assignments.

Module 2 is assessed on the basis of 1 written exam and 2-3 written assignments.

Module 3 is assessed on the basis of 1 written exam, 1 oral test and 1 written assignment.

Module 4 is assessed on the basis of 1 written exam, 1 oral test and 1 written assignment.

Module 5 is assessed on the basis of 1 written exam and 1 written assignment.

The examiner, in consultation with Disability Support Services, may deviate from the regular form of examination in order to provide a permanently disabled student with a form of examination equivalent to that of a student without a disability.

Grades

Marking scale: Fail, Pass, Pass with distinction.

For a grade of Pass on the whole course, the student must have been awarded this grade on all modules. For a grade of Pass with Distinction, the student must also have been awarded this grade on at least 18 credits

General and courses corresponding to the following Swedish Upper Secondary School Programs: English 6, Social Studies 1b/1a1+1a2, Spanish 3

Further information

1. To be admitted to the course, in addition to the requirements above, the student must be admitted to the Master's programme in Secondary Education offered jointly by Lund university.
2. The course is evaluated formatively and to a certain extent summatively at the end of the course. General issues on outcomes, course content, forms of collaboration and teaching should be central in the evaluation. Minutes/notes from the evaluation should be made available to the programme management. The evaluation report is a public document and must be signed by the course directors and elected student representatives. Experiences and views from the evaluation shall be considered and followed up in the following year's course.
